Banking structural reform

- Advance negotiations with the European Parliament.
- Trilogues will only begin after the EP finds a position.

Bank Resolution

 Take forward a new legislative proposal regarding the resolution of market infrastructures

Capital Markets Union

- Enhance the role of capital markets in financing the economy
- Establish a 'Capital Markets Union'
- Remove barriers to cross-border investment
- Encourage investment beyond capital markets
- Create incentives for other sectors to develop by improving the overall business environment

Prospectus Directive

 Improve access to financing for small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) and improve position of large businesses on EU capital markets.

Securitisation

 Ensure transparent, simple and high-quality securitisation in order to revitalise market.

Markets in Financial Instruments Directive

• Legal Review of technical standards (RTS), decision sept.

Insurance Distribution Directive

• Vote in the EP 24/11 and approval in Council in autumn.
